

This multidisciplinary artist immerses herself and tirelessly explores the realms of painting, drawing, installation, and performance. Through a collection of diverse works, deployed and articulated recursively within the operational mode of a critical reading of our society.

Everything is placed under the auspices of transgression, inhabited, haunted by personal and unsettling figures or bestiaries. Sometimes behind a very apparent naivety at first glance, the backstage of a theatre of cruelty quickly emerges and reveals tragic plays between Alpha and Omega.

The female figures that fallen angels sadly abandoned to their demons remain unsubdued and reclaim until the end the guilty and cruel power of Eros and Thanatos. They are sublimated by the richness of chromatic ranges, by the sumptuousness of colors associated with an insolent delicacy of tones.

Beyond the themes and emotional intensity contained within Aïda Schweitzer's works, a permanent struggle unfolds in the realm of painting and drawing, where a unique and indivisible body finally takes shape: that of matter and form, that of the canvas or blank paper left in reserve, bare and pure.

A universe where the mystical dances in harmony with modernity comes to life under the skilled hand of a visionary artist. The unfolding drawings invite deep exploration of the imagination, where hidden forces materialize through extraordinary creatures.

This artist's inspiration takes root in ancient mysteries, forgotten legends, and timeless tales that have woven the fabric of our understanding of the supernatural. Through a meticulously crafted contemporary bestiary, the artist gives birth to hybrid beings that seem to have escaped from a waking dream. Each of the works becomes a gateway to a realm where the fantastic intertwines with reality.

Every stroke of the pencil carries symbolic meaning, every detail is carefully arranged to evoke deep emotions and engage in introspective reflection. This parallel world thus shaped transcends the barriers of time and space, offering a timeless essence that resonates within each spectator.

The contemporary bestiary that unfolds serves as a mirror to our time, an exploration of the complex relationship between humans and nature, between the tangible and the spiritual.

Each of these creatures embodies a facet of our modern experience, whether it be the quest for truth, the struggle for harmony, or the aspiration for transcendence.

This collection of drawings invites us to dive into a universe where the mystical and the contemporary blend harmoniously, where the boundaries between reality and imagination blur.








The Beast Within Me 2022 Luxembourg (LU)






